

Attention All 125 Over 40 Drivers and Clubman Over 40 Drivers

Recent discussions at the past couple of club days has led to TKC moving to trial the combining of a 125 Restricted (Over 40) class and Sportsman 100(Over 40) for the remaining 4 club runs of the year.

The concept is to enable the club to obtain some data via the AMB transponder system as to the compatibility of the classes with a view to being combined for 2012. This decision will be discussed at the AGM meeting in October 2011.

As such the following will occur for the next 4 remaining Club Runs for 2011.

1. The combined 125R (Over 40) and Clubman (Over 40) will run together on the track in a combined format separate to all other classes.
2. 125R drivers still wanting to compete in their respective 125R classes to maintain their club class points can do both classes at a club day if they choose with a nominal fee of \$10.00 for the second class.
3. The format will be for 125R (Over 40 Light) drivers will start at the front followed by 125R Heavy and then Sportsman 100 Over 40. Any 'P' plated Over 40's from any of the 3 classes will start rear of field.

The purpose of the above is to assess the compatibility of the classes involved for Over 40 drivers – NOTHING is yet decided on parity at this point and how or if this will be done. For the time being drivers will run with their normal class weights, restrictors etc for their class.

However with a view to the future (2012) it is worthwhile for competitors to give some consideration as to how parity may be achieved in various ways and there is an opportunity for the Over 40's class to perhaps experiment a bit in determining this. For example:

1. Weights – as per current arrangements.
2. Class differentiation but running together i.e. 125R (Over 40 Light), 125R (Over 40 Heavy), Sportsman100 Over 40
3. Club Restrictor for this class only – as opposed to weight penalty.
4. Any other suggestions?

WHAT DO YOU NEED TO DO?

This is for those drivers Over the age of 40 ONLY – it **does not** affect other 125 classes/drivers.

- At the next club run nominate for either 125R Heavy Over 40's, 125 Light Over 40's or Sportsman 100 Over 40's.(May not be able to do 'online' a manual entry at club day will be required)
- If you wish to still compete in your normal 125R Class for your club points nominate and race in that class also for an additional entry fee of \$10.00
